Three Teenagers Arrested After Traralgon Car Chase

Three teenagers were arrested in Traralgon on July 24 after a dramatic vehicle pursuit involving the Baw Baw Crime Investigation Unit and the Morwell Divisional Response Unit.

Three teenagers were arrested in Traralgon on the afternoon of July 24, 2025, following a high-speed pursuit involving officers from the Baw Baw Crime Investigation Unit and the Morwell Divisional Response Unit.

The incident began around 2:17 p.m. when police on patrol spotted a red Mazda CX3 traveling south on Strzelecki Highway. The vehicle caught the attention of officers, who suspected it may have been connected to earlier reports of criminal activity. When police

attempted to intercept the vehicle, the driver failed to stop, prompting an extended follow through the local area.

According to Victoria Police, the chase covered a considerable distance and involved coordinated efforts between multiple units. Officers managed the pursuit carefully to minimize risk to the public while keeping the suspects in sight. The pursuit concluded when the vehicle came to a stop, and all three teenagers inside were arrested without further incident.

The arrested individuals, all teenagers, were taken into custody at the scene and are now assisting police with their inquiries. At the time of writing, no injuries have been reported, and authorities have not released further details about the teenagers' identities or the specific charges they may face.

The red Mazda CX3 was seized as part of the investigation. Police have not confirmed whether the car was stolen or how it became involved in the incident.

The Baw Baw Crime Investigation Unit and the Morwell Divisional Response Unit have remained tight-lipped about the broader context of the arrest, although investigations are ongoing. More information is expected to be released as inquiries continue.
