## Trainee Cop Jailed for Torturing Youth in Faisalabad

A trainee sub-inspector at Factory Area Police Station in Faisalabad, Pakistan, has been arrested and imprisoned following the emergence of a video showing him brutally torturing a young man during an unauthorized interrogation. The incident, which has sparked public outrage, underscores serious concerns about police misconduct and the abuse of power within law enforcement. The Faisalabad police acted swiftly to detain the officer after the footage came to light, highlighting the need for accountability in the system.

The suspect, identified as a trainee sub-inspector, was recorded subjecting the victim to physical abuse in a bid to extract a confession, according to a statement from Faisalabad City Police Officer (CPO) Kamran Adil. The interrogation took place without legal

justification, violating standard procedures outlined in the Pakistan Penal Code (PPC). The video prompted immediate action, with the officer charged under relevant sections of the PPC for assault and abuse of authority, as reported by *The Express Tribune*. CPO Adil emphasized that such behavior tarnishes the police force's reputation and assured the public of a thorough investigation.

The victim, a local youth whose identity remains protected, was reportedly detained without formal charges, a practice that has drawn criticism from local activists. A senior police official, speaking to *Dawn News*, condemned the incident, stating that the department is committed to rooting out such misconduct. The officer has been suspended pending a departmental inquiry, and the case has been referred to the courts for further action. The Faisalabad police have also vowed to implement stricter oversight to prevent similar incidents.

This case echoes broader issues within Pakistan's law enforcement, where allegations of excessive force have long eroded public trust. Community leaders are now calling for comprehensive reforms, including better training and accountability measures for officers. As the investigation unfolds, the incident serves as a stark reminder of the need for vigilance to ensure justice and protect citizens from abuse. The Faisalabad police are under pressure to restore confidence, with the public closely watching the outcome of this troubling case.
