Burnside Man Arrested for Sexual Abuse of Two Young Girls

A 66-year-old man from Burnside, Kentucky, was taken into custody on August 6 following serious allegations involving two young children.

Daryl Kimball was arrested at his home without incident, following months of investigation into claims that he forced two girls, ages three and four, into inappropriate sexual contact. The investigation began in April after the alleged abuse was first reported to authorities.

Kimball now faces a charge of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree, with the victims reportedly being under the age of twelve. According to officials, he is currently being held at the Pulaski County Detention Center. His bond has been set at \$50,000.

This recent arrest comes after a thorough review of the case, which authorities say remains open as the investigation continues. No further details have been released at this time regarding any potential additional charges or court appearances.

The charge of Sexual Abuse in the First Degree is considered a Class C felony under Kentucky law, especially when the victim is a child. If convicted, Kimball could face significant prison time, along with mandatory registration as a sex offender.

Law enforcement has not released information about how the case was initially brought to light, nor have they confirmed whether there are additional victims. For now, the focus remains on ensuring justice is pursued in accordance with the law.

This is a developing case; further updates are expected as the investigation develops.
