## Bitget Partners with Indian Crypto Leader to Boost Blockchain and AI in Southeast Asia

Bitget, a global cryptocurrency exchange and Web3 technology company, has partnered with prominent Indian Key Opinion Leader (KOL) Pushpendra Singh to strengthen blockchain and artificial intelligence (AI) collaboration across Southeast Asia. Founded in 2018, Bitget has grown into one of the world's leading cryptocurrency platforms, with over 120 million users across more than 150 countries. The exchange is known for its copy trading features and diverse crypto services. Its affiliate product Bitget Wallet, formerly BitKeep, serves as a non-custodial wallet supporting over 130 blockchains and providing access to thousands of decentralized applications (DApps).

The company has invested in global education and adoption initiatives, partnering with the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) to provide blockchain education to over one million individuals by 2027. Additionally, Bitget has formed strategic partnerships with major sporting entities, including LALIGA and MotoGP™, to increase cryptocurrency awareness through mainstream platforms.
