Police Continue Search for Man Wanted in Oxfordshire Rape Case

Thames Valley Police are continuing their search for a 40-year-old man wanted in connection with a serious sexual assault that took place in Oxfordshire in June. Officers have issued renewed appeals to the public for information as concern grows over his whereabouts and welfare.

The individual, identified as Robert Farndon, is sought for questioning regarding a case of rape and assault. Farndon is described as a white male of slim build, with long brown hair, partial facial hair, and brown eyes. Authorities believe he was last seen on Friday, June 27, in the Buckingham Road area of Gawcott, Buckinghamshire.

Farndon has been missing since Thursday, June 26, and is known to frequent several locations, including Bletchley, Wheatley, Buckingham, and the wider Silverstone area. Despite ongoing efforts by detectives, he has not been located, and police have expressed concern for his welfare.

Detective Inspector Richard Allmond, leading the investigation, emphasised the importance of public cooperation: "We are urgently appealing for the public's help in locating Robert. Since he has been wanted, our officers have been working extensively to trace him. We believe Robert was last seen around three weeks ago in the Gawcott area and have since been growing concerned for his welfare."

Members of the public are urged not to approach Farndon if seen. Instead, they are advised to contact emergency services immediately by calling 999. Non-emergency information can be reported by calling 101 or submitting details online, quoting reference number 2143 of the current date. Additionally, individuals can provide anonymous tips through the independent charity Crimestoppers at 0800 555 111.

The investigation remains active as officers continue to follow leads. Authorities are urging anyone with relevant knowledge, no matter how minor it may seem, to come forward.
