Missing Toddler Found Begging on Karachi Streets

A missing three-year-old child was discovered begging on the streets of Karachi, raising serious concerns about child safety and abduction in Pakistan’s largest city.

In a deeply troubling incident, a three-year-old boy who had gone missing was found begging on the streets of Karachi, drawing widespread attention to the growing issue of child safety and exploitation in Pakistan’s largest city.

The child, whose identity has been withheld for protection, was reported missing by his family earlier this week. After an intense search and growing concern from both relatives and

local communities, the toddler was shockingly found in a public area, begging for money, an alarming discovery that has raised serious questions about child trafficking and neglect.

According to police sources, the boy appeared disoriented and frightened. Authorities are now investigating how he ended up in such a condition and who may be responsible for his disappearance and possible exploitation. While no arrests have been made yet, law enforcement officials have confirmed that they are pursuing all leads, including potential involvement of criminal networks that exploit children for begging or other illegal activities.
