Pakistan Launches Haval H6 PHEV, Boosting Industry

Lahore, 16 August 2025, Pakistan's automobile industry reached a new milestone on Saturday with the launch of the Haval H6 Plug-in Hybrid Electric Vehicle (PHEV) by Sazgar Engineering Limited at the Expo Centre in Lahore.
