Anthony Davis Lists Lavish \$39.9 Million Bel-Air Mansion After Move to Mavericks

NBA star Anthony Davis has officially put his Bel-Air mansion on the market, listing the high-end property for a staggering \$39.9 million just months after being traded from the Los Angeles Lakers to the Dallas Mavericks. The luxury estate, located in one of Los Angeles's most prestigious neighborhoods, reflects the kind of lifestyle only elite athletes can afford, and marks a notable shift as Davis settles into his new chapter in Texas.

The estate is situated on Stratford Circle in Bel-Air, a gated community known for housing some of California's wealthiest residents. With eight bedrooms, 12 bathrooms, and an

impressive array of upscale features, the home is more than just a residence, it's a full-blown retreat. The listing comes roughly half a year after Davis was dealt to the Mavericks in a headline-making move that shocked Lakers fans.

Davis, who helped lead the Lakers to an NBA (National Basketball Association) championship in 2020 alongside LeBron James, originally purchased the property for approximately \$31 million. The current asking price suggests a substantial gain on the investment, pending a successful sale. According to KTLA, the home's opulence matches Davis's reputation on the court.

Inside, the house boasts everything from an elevator and a private movie theater to a wellness spa complete with a sauna and plunge pool. There's even a fully equipped game room with a wet bar and a wine cellar. For those who appreciate personal grooming without leaving the house, the property includes a built-in barber shop.

The outdoor amenities are equally extravagant. A full-size, lighted tennis court, an Olympic-style swimming pool, and multiple fire pits provide plenty of space for entertainment and relaxation. One of the more unique features is a custom-made children's playhouse with its own HVAC (heating, ventilation, and air conditioning) system, designed to mirror the main residence in style and comfort.

TMZ reported that Jordan Cohen of RE/MAX ONE is the official listing agent for the estate. The real estate expert is known for representing high-profile celebrity homes, and this listing is no exception. With outdoor cabanas, a chef's kitchen built for entertaining, and manicured landscaping throughout the grounds, the property is positioned to attract affluent buyers seeking luxury in Los Angeles.

His time with the Lakers will be remembered for that 2020 championship run during a turbulent season, and this real estate move may mark the final goodbye to his time in the City of Angels. While the sale could yield a sizable return, Davis still faces the reality of finding the right space to settle in Texas.
