

## Chicago River North Mass Shooting Kills 4, Injures 14

A tragic night unfolded in Chicago's River North neighborhood late Wednesday, as a mass shooting left four people dead and 14 others wounded. The violence erupted shortly after 11 p.m. near the Artis Restaurant & Lounge, located on the 300 block of West Chicago Avenue.

According to Chicago police, a large crowd had gathered outside the lounge following a listening party for local rapper Mello Buckzz. The event brought together many community members, fans, and music lovers who were enjoying the night.

Suddenly, a dark-colored vehicle drove by the crowd, and someone inside opened fire. The sound of gunshots shattered the evening's calm, sending people scrambling for safety. The vehicle sped away from the scene, leaving chaos and confusion behind.

Emergency responders rushed to the area, treating the wounded and transporting victims to nearby hospitals. The identities of those affected have not yet been released, and the police have not confirmed the motives behind the attack.

Detectives are actively investigating the shooting. Despite the severity of the incident, no arrests have been made so far, and police are appealing to the public for any information that could assist in solving the case.

This shooting is another painful reminder of the ongoing challenges Chicago faces with gun violence. River North, known for its vibrant nightlife, art galleries, and restaurants, has recently been shaken by this sudden outbreak of violence, raising concerns about safety in the area.
