Man Stabbed in Salford Street as Police Launch Attempted Murder Investigation

A quiet Sunday night in Salford took a frightening turn when a man was stabbed on Capella Walk, just off Lower Broughton Road. The incident happened shortly after 10 p.m. on July 6, prompting a swift response from emergency services.

Greater Manchester Police (GMP) confirmed they were called to the scene following reports of a disturbance. When officers arrived, they found a man in his 50s suffering from stab wounds. Paramedics treated him on the spot before rushing him to hospital. Fortunately, his condition is currently described as stable.

A second man, also in his 50s, was arrested at the scene on suspicion of attempted murder. He remains in police custody this morning as detectives continue their investigation.

The street was quickly cordoned off as officers secured the area late into the night. Images from the scene show a strong police presence, with patrol cars and tape blocking off parts of Lower Broughton Road and nearby Heath Avenue. GMP later confirmed that a knife was recovered in connection with the case.

Residents were left shaken by the incident, with many expressing concern about violence so close to home. "It's scary to think something like that can happen right on your doorstep," one neighbour said. "We just hope the man recovers and that the police get to the bottom of what happened."

GMP is continuing to investigate the circumstances leading up to the incident. While they have not yet released further details about the relationship between the two men, or what may have caused the confrontation, officers are urging anyone with information to come forward.

Police have not issued any warnings to the wider public, and they believe this was an isolated incident. Nevertheless, their presence remains visible in the area as part of the ongoing investigation.

As the investigation unfolds, residents are left hoping for clarity and peace, following a night of unexpected violence in an otherwise quiet neighbourhood.
