## Woman Fatally Shot While Asleep at Punjab Farmhouse

Unconfirmed reports have surfaced claiming that a woman was allegedly shot and killed while sleeping at a farmhouse in Chak No. 267 RB, reportedly under the jurisdiction of Dijkot Police Station. The incident allegedly occurred late Wednesday night, but no official confirmation has yet been issued by local authorities or major news outlets.

The woman has been identified in unverified accounts as 55-year-old Sajida Parveen. Sources claim she had been living alone at the farmhouse, located on the outskirts of the village, at the time of the alleged attack. According to these accounts, unknown individuals

entered the property during the night and opened fire, fatally injuring the woman before fleeing the scene.

Residents of the area reportedly contacted local authorities after hearing gunshots.

Allegedly, officers from Dijkot Police Station responded to the report, and the victim's body was taken to a nearby hospital for post-mortem examination. However, there are no public statements from the police department or hospital officials confirming these details.

An unnamed source cited in preliminary accounts suggested that law enforcement may be considering the case as a possible targeted attack. Despite these claims, there have been no reports of arrests or identification of suspects at this time. Investigators are said to be reviewing possible evidence, including CCTV footage from nearby areas, although these claims have not been verified.

The incident, if confirmed, would raise fresh concerns about the vulnerability of individuals living alone in rural and remote locations. Residents in some outlying areas of Faisalabad have previously voiced concerns over the lack of surveillance and emergency response infrastructure.

No verified witness accounts or official statements from the victim's family have been made available, and no First Information Report (FIR) has been found in publicly accessible records as of the time of writing. The Punjab Police and other relevant authorities have not issued any press release or statement regarding this specific case.

Given the lack of confirmation from authoritative sources, readers are advised to view these reports with caution. Efforts are ongoing to verify the details through official channels. Updates will be provided if and when law enforcement agencies or credible media confirm the facts surrounding the alleged incident.
