Teen Shot at Cleveland's Shaker Tower Apartments in Early Morning Incident

A 17-year-old boy was shot early Monday morning at an apartment complex near Shaker Square in Cleveland, Ohio.

The incident occurred just before 2 a.m. at the Shaker Tower Apartments, located in the 13800 block of Shaker Boulevard.

Cleveland Police and Emergency Medical Services (EMS) responded to the scene following reports of a shooting involving a teenager. Upon arrival, EMS personnel transported the 17-

year-old male to a nearby hospital for treatment.

Officials have not released the identity of the 17-year-old male involved in the shooting. Additionally, no information has been provided regarding the extent of his injuries or current medical condition.

As of the moment, there have been no updates from local authorities or hospital representatives about whether the teenager remains in critical care, has undergone surgery, or is in stable condition.

The circumstances leading up to the shooting have also not yet been clarified by authorities. As of now, no information about a suspect or motive has been provided. The Cleveland Police Department has not confirmed whether the shooting occurred inside the apartment complex or in the surrounding area.

Investigators are continuing their work to determine the events that led to the teenager being shot. No additional injuries have been reported in connection with the incident.

Local residents in the Shaker Square area are encouraged to remain vigilant and contact police with any information that could assist in the investigation. There have been no public safety alerts issued related to the shooting, and no arrests have been announced as of this writing.

The case remains active, with Cleveland police urging anyone with knowledge of the incident to come forward.
