Bitcoin Price Outlook: Can BTC Reach \$150K by 2025 and \$350K by 2031?

Bitcoin is currently trading around \$118,000 following a 45% rise after the U.S. presidential election. Analysts forecast potential price targets of \$160,000 by the end of 2025 and up to \$350,000 by 2031, citing factors such as the recent halving and institutional investment.

Technical analysis reveals key levels to watch, with immediate resistance at \$119,883 and support holding firm at \$114,519. The daily chart shows renewed buying interest, with trading volume spiking to \$950 million as investors renewed buying interest on minor pullbacks.

“Bitcoin’s resilience above \$118K signals strong accumulation by long-term holders,” notes market strategist James Carter. The Fibonacci retracement levels suggest consolidation could precede another upward move, particularly if macroeconomic conditions remain favorable.

The 2024 halving event, a pre-programmed reduction in Bitcoin’s mini  rewards, has historically triggered bull runs by tightening supply.

Combined with accelerating institutional investment through spot Bitcoin exchange-traded funds (ETFs), this scarcity effect could propel prices toward \$160,000 by year-end. Meanwhile, political tailwinds, including regulatory clarity under the new administration, have bolstered confidence. “The ‘Trump trade’ reflects a broader shift toward financial sovereignty,” says hedge fund manager Alicia Reynolds. “Bitcoin is increasingly seen as a hedge against fiscal instability.”

Looking ahead, skeptics caution that regulatory hurdles or a macroeconomic downturn could temper gains. Yet if adoption trends persist with corporations and nation-states adding BTC to balance sheets, the \$350,000 target by 2031 appears plausible. While volatility remains inevitable, Bitcoin’s fundamentals have never been stronger. For investors willing to navigate the turbulence, the coming years may validate crypto’s promise as a transformative store of value.
