## Inside Selena Gomez and Benny Blanco's \$35M Beverly Hills Dream Home

Selena Gomez and fiancé Benny Blanco gave fans a rare peek into their \$35 million Beverly Hills mansion. They shared a quiet celebration of Gomez's birthday that included a sweet gift from pop superstar Taylor Swift. Their home, which features luxury amenities and a warm, personalized touch, continues to reflect their growing life together.

The couple, who got engaged in December 2024, recently opened up their lavish California residence to followers on social media. Producer Benny Blanco posted several images capturing intimate moments from their low-key celebration, including shots of a homemade

sourdough loaf from Taylor Swift. The singer, 35, gifted the couple a charming basket with freshly baked bread and a candle from Le Labo, adding a handwritten sticker that read “Home-Made Sourdough” and “It’s a loaf story”, a playful nod to her hit song “Love Story.” Another label simply said, “For Selena + Benny,” and she signed off, “Love, Taylor.”

The kitchen where the gift sat featured an elegant marble countertop, just one of many high-end details throughout their 12-bathroom, seven-bedroom property. Their estate also includes two guesthouses, one with a professional-grade studio, the other with a state-of-the-art home theater.

Benny Blanco, 37, shared photos of Gomez napping and relaxing throughout the home. The photos capture natural light streaming through large windows, highlighting the estate’s spacious wooden floors. “Our life is a dream ... so I’m never waking you up ... happy birthday, my love,” he captioned the post.

Gomez, 33, has called the past year “the most beautiful,” both in her personal life and creatively. After keeping things private for six months, the couple first confirmed their relationship publicly in late 2023. Their romance blossomed after years of professional collaborations, eventually leading to their recent joint work on Gomez’s 2025 album *I Said I Love You First*, featuring the deeply personal lead single “Scared of Loving You.”

Blanco has not been shy about his affection for the singer. In an interview with *Interview* magazine, he revealed, “The second we started hanging out, I was like, ‘This is my wife.’ I was telling my mom, ‘This is the girl I’m going to marry.’”

Their estate, which they purchased in an off-market deal through a limited liability company (LLC) associated with Blanco’s business manager, is among the priciest properties sold in Beverly Hills in 2024. The deal, finalized on December 4, closed for a reported \$35 million, and public records show the mansion was last sold in August 2021 for \$30.7 million.

The estate, built in a Spanish-style design, offers a spiral staircase, a private library, a solarium greenhouse, and a full-scale fitness center. According to celebrity news outlet *TMZ*, its previous owner was a prominent Hollywood director.

The grounds feature lush landscaping and refined stone paving around the pool. Blanco is known for his love of gardening and giving back to the community, so the home’s greenhouse is a meaningful addition that complements the couple’s lifestyle.

As wedding planning continues, Gomez and Blanco appear to be settling into domestic bliss, enjoying the quiet comforts of their home and the support of close friends like Swift. Their Beverly Hills haven is more than just a mansion; it's the setting of their love story, still unfolding one loaf at a time.
