Snooker Club Owner Fatally Shot During Dispute in Purana Golimar

A violent confrontation in Purana Golimar resulted in the death of a local snooker club owner, raising serious questions about public safety and law enforcement effectiveness in the area. The incident, which took place near Eidgah Ground, has once again highlighted ongoing concerns regarding unchecked violence and the inadequacy of current security measures.

The victim, 45-year-old Khurshid Ahmed, was critically injured in a shooting that occurred during a dispute within the jurisdiction of Rizvia Police Station. According to police sources, Mr. Ahmed was shot from behind, with the bullet striking his hip. The injury caused heavy

bleeding, and despite swift medical intervention at Civil Hospital, he succumbed to his wounds.

Preliminary investigations indicate that the shooting was not random but arose out of a personal or business-related dispute. However, details about the exact cause and the individuals involved remain unclear, as authorities continue their inquiry. The Rizvia Police Station has opened a case, and investigators are actively seeking witnesses and any additional evidence that might lead to the apprehension of the suspects.

This incident is not an isolated case but part of a broader pattern of violent crimes occurring in the area, which have alarmed residents and business owners alike. Purana Golimar, a historically vibrant neighborhood, has been increasingly marred by criminal activity over the past few years. Locals have expressed frustration over what they describe as inadequate police presence and slow responses to emergency calls.

Community leaders and business owners are calling for immediate action to restore law and order. Many argue that the current government's approach to public safety has been insufficient, with resources stretched thin and policies that fail to address the root causes of violence. The growing sense of insecurity has not only affected daily life but has also harmed local commerce, as people hesitate to frequent public places after dark.

Experts on urban safety emphasize that combating such violence requires a multifaceted strategy. Effective policing must be combined with community engagement, better intelligence gathering, and targeted social programs to reduce tensions. Without a coordinated effort, incidents like the fatal shooting of Khurshid Ahmed are likely to continue, undermining trust in law enforcement and the government's ability to protect its citizens.

In the wake of the tragedy, there have been renewed calls for accountability and transparency in ongoing investigations. The Rizvia Police Station has assured the public that every effort is being made to bring the perpetrators to justice swiftly. However, many remain skeptical, pointing to a history of unresolved crimes and lackluster prosecution.

The loss of Khurshid Ahmed is a sobering reminder of the consequences of failing to adequately address security challenges. As authorities investigate the shooting, the community watches closely, hoping this incident will catalyze meaningful change rather than another tragic statistic. The need for a stronger, more proactive stance on law

enforcement and public safety is clear, not just in Purana Golimar but across all neighborhoods facing similar threats.
