Mohsin Naqvi Directs Sweeping Reforms for FIA Modernization

On July 21, 2025, Federal Interior Minister Mohsin Naqvi visited the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA) headquarters in Islamabad to announce a comprehensive reform initiative aimed at modernizing the agency's operations and strengthening its efforts against illegal activities such as human smuggling and immigration fraud.
