## Serendipity Arts Foundation Hosts 2025 Residency Open Studio in Delhi

The Serendipity Arts Foundation has launched its Open Studio for the 2025 artist residency in New Delhi, running through August 8. The showcase invites the public to engage with new work developed by a diverse group of emerging and mid-career artists during their residency.

Held annually, the Open Studio marks the culmination of the foundation's residency program. It provides selected artists with space, time, and resources to explore ideas and produce work across disciplines, including visual art, performance, multimedia, and installations.

This year's residency cohort reflects the foundation's commitment to supporting a broad range of artistic voices. Participants span various practices and backgrounds, with many using the residency to experiment with form, medium, and collaborative processes. The public showcase allows visitors to witness the results of this experimentation, often through in-progress or site-specific works.

Since its inception, Serendipity Arts Foundation has established itself as a key institution in India's contemporary art scene. Known for supporting interdisciplinary and experimental work, the foundation's residency program plays a central role in nurturing new talent and challenging traditional exhibition norms.

As the Delhi Open Studio continues through August 8, it offers art enthusiasts a unique opportunity to engage with current creative practices and connect with some of India's most promising contemporary artists.
