

Suspect Dead After Shooting at Atlanta Pharmacy Near Emory University

ATLANTA – Authorities confirmed that the suspect involved in a shooting inside a pharmacy near Emory University in Atlanta has been killed. The incident also left at least one police officer injured, according to law enforcement sources.

The shooting unfolded inside a busy pharmacy located near Emory University. Emergency responders arrived swiftly after receiving reports of gunfire inside the establishment.

Law enforcement sources revealed that the suspect opened fire inside the pharmacy, prompting a rapid police response. In the ensuing confrontation, officers engaged the suspect, ultimately neutralizing the threat.

One police officer sustained injuries during the incident and was immediately treated by medical personnel. Details about the officer's current condition have not been released, but authorities say the injuries are being taken seriously.
