Teenage Girl Arrested After Fatal NSW Stabbing

A teenage girl has been arrested following a fatal stabbing in Edgeworth, a suburb in the Lake Macquarie region of New South Wales.

Emergency services were called to a residence on Euston Close around 10:20 pm on Monday, 4 August 2025, after reports of a stabbing. When officers from the Lake Macquarie Police District arrived, they found a teenage girl suffering from a serious injury to her torso.

Paramedics from NSW Ambulance provided initial medical treatment at the scene before transporting the injured girl to hospital. Despite efforts to save her, she died shortly after arrival. The girl has not yet been formally identified by authorities.

Police confirmed that the girl who was arrested at the scene was known to the victim. She is also a teenager and is currently assisting police with their inquiries. No further details about their relationship have been publicly disclosed.

A crime scene has been established at the property, and specialist forensic officers have begun examining the area for evidence. Investigators from the State Crime Command's Homicide Squad are now working with local police to determine the circumstances surrounding the incident.

Authorities have not released information regarding a possible motive or whether any weapons have been recovered at this stage of the investigation. No charges have yet been laid as inquiries are ongoing.

The Edgeworth community, located approximately 20 kilometers west of Newcastle, has expressed shock at the incident, which occurred in what is generally considered a quiet residential area.

New South Wales Police have asked anyone with information or footage relevant to the case to come forward and contact Crime Stoppers. As the investigation is still in its early stages, further updates are expected in the coming days.

The names of both the deceased and the arrested individual have been withheld due to their ages and legal protections surrounding juvenile cases in Australia.

This incident marks another tragic case of youth violence in the region and adds to growing concerns about the need for stronger community intervention and support services for at-risk young people.
