Trump Considers Revoking Rosie O'Donnell's Citizenship

President Donald Trump has reignited his long-running feud with comedian Rosie O'Donnell, announcing he is seriously weighing whether to revoke her United States citizenship after she moved to Ireland.

Trump and O'Donnell have exchanged insults for nearly two decades, a bitter dynamic that first took shape in 2006 when O'Donnell, then a co-host on the talk show *The View*, publicly

criticised Trump's decision to forgive a Miss USA contestant's misconduct. At the time, O'Donnell accused Trump of being a "snake-oil salesman," questioning the former president's business credentials and calling into doubt his self-made image. Trump responded swiftly, labelling O'Donnell a "real loser" and "a woman out of control," setting the tone for years of personal attacks.

This latest episode unfolded after O'Donnell, now 63, appeared on the Irish radio programme Sunday with Miriam, where she explained why she continues to stand firmly against Trump. She described him as a racist and sexist figure who she believes poses a risk to women and children globally. Her comments appeared to fuel Trump's latest salvo. Posting to his platform, Truth Social, Trump declared O'Donnell a "threat to humanity" and said he was giving "serious consideration" to stripping her of her citizenship, adding that she should remain in Ireland "if they want her."

Trump's suggestion of revoking citizenship is not without controversy, as constitutional scholars have frequently noted that the United States Constitution protects citizens from losing their nationality without due process. Nonetheless, the former president's statement underscores how personal animosity can still command national attention, especially when it involves a high-profile critic.

For her part, O'Donnell expressed no regrets over her opposition to Trump, stating she is "very proud" to have consistently challenged his conduct and rhetoric. The clash illustrates the deep cultural and political divides that persist in America, where celebrity figures and political leaders often become entangled in public disputes that blur the line between entertainment and governance.
