England Face Sweden in Euro 2025 Quarter-Final Showdown

England's Lionesses are poised for a thrilling Women's Euro 2025 quarter-final against Sweden, as they aim to edge closer to retaining their coveted title. Sarina Wiegman's squad, galvanised after a rocky start, face a formidable Swedish side at Zurich's Letzigrund stadium tonight, with kick-off at 8 pm U.K.time.

The Lionesses stumbled in their opening match, falling to France, which sparked fears of an early exit.
