Pakistan's Pledge for Regional Peace and Prosperity with Allies

On July 26, 2025, Chief of Army Staff (COAS) Field Marshal Syed Asim Munir reaffirmed Pakistan's commitment to fostering a secure and prosperous regional environment through cooperation with allied nations. The statement was made during the Regional Chiefs of Defence Staff Conference held in Islamabad, where military leaders from the United States, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan convened to discuss regional security challenges.

The conference, themed "Strengthening Bonds, Securing Peace," emphasized the importance of enhanced military-to-military cooperation amid evolving transnational

threats and hybrid challenges. COAS Munir highlighted Pakistan's dedication to working closely with partner countries to promote stability in Central and South Asia. Discussions focused on counterterrorism collaboration, cyber security, and joint training exercises. Pakistan's Inter-Services Public Relations (ISPR) described the conference as a significant step toward advancing regional security cooperation.

Participants stressed the need for mutual trust and strategic dialogue to address issues such as terrorism, cyber threats, and violent extremism. Delegates reaffirmed their commitment to safeguarding national sovereignty and maintaining peace in the region. The conference also reflected Pakistan's broader approach to regional security, which includes coordinated humanitarian responses and information sharing to tackle complex challenges.

Recent diplomatic engagements by COAS Munir, including meetings with Chinese military officials and the naval chief of Saudi Arabia, underscore Pakistan's efforts to strengthen ties with key allies. These activities support Pakistan's role as a stabilizing force in the region.

By hosting this multilateral conference, Pakistan reinforced its strategic vision of inclusive defense diplomacy and regional cooperation. The event drew appreciation from international partners, highlighting Pakistan's constructive role in promoting peace and security in a volatile geopolitical environment.
