President Trump Inaugurates Expanded Trump International Golf Links in Aberdeen

Former U.S. President Donald Trump took part in a grand opening ceremony at Trump International Golf Links in Aberdeen, Scotland, marking the official launch of a second 18-hole course. The expansion brings the total to 36 championship holes, further cementing the resort's position as a top golfing destination in the United Kingdom.
