

Active Shooter Reported at Emory University Atlanta Campus

Emory University in Atlanta issued an emergency alert on Friday afternoon following reports of an active shooter on its campus near Emory Point. Students and staff were immediately advised to avoid the area and take necessary safety precautions.

The university's College of Arts and Sciences, which serves over 5,700 undergraduate students, posted a message on its official social media account urging the campus

community to follow the “RUN. HIDE. FIGHT.” protocol in response to the threat. This guidance is part of standard active shooter safety procedures designed to help individuals protect themselves during such incidents.

Authorities from the Emory University Police Department, DeKalb Police Department, and DeKalb County Sheriff’s Office responded promptly to the alert. However, as of Friday afternoon, these agencies had not provided official comment to media outlets regarding the situation.

The emergency notification instructed students and staff to avoid Emory Point, a mixed-use area of the campus that includes retail and residential spaces. University officials emphasized the importance of following safety protocols and remaining vigilant until the threat is resolved.

Emory University is known for its active and diverse student population. The College of Arts and Sciences, the primary undergraduate division, has more than 5,700 enrolled students. The campus community has been advised to cooperate fully with law enforcement and university personnel to ensure safety.

Active shooter incidents on university campuses remain rare but serious events that require immediate and coordinated responses. Institutions typically implement emergency alert systems and training exercises to prepare students and staff for such scenarios.

Local law enforcement agencies continue to investigate the incident and have increased their presence on and around the Emory University campus. Residents and visitors are advised to avoid the area while authorities work to secure the situation.

Officials have yet to confirm the number of individuals involved or report any casualties. Updates are expected as more information becomes available.

This event highlights ongoing concerns about campus security and the importance of rapid communication between universities and law enforcement in emergencies. Emory University officials have reiterated their commitment to student safety and crisis management.

The university community and local authorities remain on high alert as the investigation continues. Students and staff are encouraged to stay informed through official channels and follow all safety instructions.
