Sydney Police Search for Missing 13-Year-Old Eva Blackstone

Police have launched an urgent search for 13-year-old Eva Blackstone, who was reported missing from the Northern Beaches area in Sydney on Thursday, 7 August 2025.

Eva was last seen around 8:30 am in Manly Vale, a residential suburb on Sydney's Northern Beaches. After she failed to make contact with her family or be located, officers from the Northern Beaches Police Area Command were notified and immediately began inquiries into her whereabouts.

Due to Eva's age and the circumstances of her disappearance, authorities have expressed growing concern for her safety and well-being. Police are now calling on the public to assist with any information that may help locate the missing teenager.

Eva Blackstone is described as being of Caucasian appearance, approximately 170cm tall, with a slim build and shoulder-length brown hair. At the time she was last seen, she was wearing a navy blue school jumper, black track suit pants, and black shoes. She was also carrying a black backpack.

Police believe Eva may still be in the Northern Beaches area, which she is known to frequent. Investigators are reviewing local CCTV footage, speaking with residents, and following up on any possible sightings reported to them.

Authorities urge anyone who may have seen Eva or who has information about her location to contact Northern Beaches Police or call Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000. All information can be provided anonymously.

No further details have been released at this stage. Police continue to treat the matter with urgency and are maintaining close contact with Eva's family during the investigation.

Members of the public are encouraged to share this appeal across social media and within their communities, particularly in areas around Manly Vale and the broader Northern Beaches region.

This case remains an active investigation.
