Police Appeal to Find Missing Man in Pemulwuy

New South Wales Police Force is urging the public to help locate a man reported missing from Pemulwuy, with concerns growing for his welfare.

The New South Wales Police Force is appealing to the public for assistance in locating a man who has been reported missing from the western Sydney suburb of Pemulwuy. Concerns for the man's welfare have grown since he was last seen, prompting an active search and a call for community support.

According to police, the man was reported missing after he failed to make contact with family and friends, which is considered out of character. Officers from the Cumberland Police Area Command have taken charge of the investigation and are urging anyone who may have seen the man or has relevant information to come forward as soon as possible.

Police have not disclosed the man's identity at this stage, likely to protect his privacy and that of his family. However, they are working closely with loved ones and are continuing to follow all available leads.

Community members are being reminded that if they see anyone matching the man's description or notice anything unusual, they should not hesitate to contact Crime Stoppers or the nearest police station.

The New South Wales Police Force continues to prioritise the case and has reassured the public that they are doing everything possible to find the missing man. As the search continues, community support remains crucial.

This incident highlights the importance of public awareness and cooperation during missing person investigations. Authorities remain hopeful that with ongoing help from the community, the man will soon be found safe and well.
