Tando Allahyar Teen Girl Allegedly Abducted by Influential Man

A teenage girl from Tando Allahyar has reportedly gone missing under suspicious circumstances, with her family alleging abduction by an influential figure from Naushehro Feroze district.

Muskan Dawoodpoto, a local school-going teenager, was last seen earlier this week. Her sudden disappearance has sparked concerns among her relatives and community members, who are calling for a thorough investigation.

Speaking at a press conference held on Monday, Muskan's mother leveled serious accusations against a man she described as politically connected and influential in the Naushehro Feroze area. "We do not doubt that my daughter has been kidnapped. The man behind this has power and reach, but we demand justice," she said, visibly distressed.

While details about the accused individual have not been officially disclosed, the family claims to have provided relevant information to the police. However, they also expressed frustration over what they believe is a lack of swift action by the authorities.

Local law enforcement officials have acknowledged the filing of a missing persons report. A police spokesperson confirmed that the case is under investigation, and efforts are being made to locate Muskan. "We are following all leads and taking this matter seriously," he said.

Civil society representatives and human rights activists in the region have also raised concerns about the growing number of such cases where vulnerable individuals are allegedly targeted by those with political or financial influence. They urged the police to act impartially and ensure the safe recovery of the missing girl.

No arrests have been made so far, and further details will depend on the outcome of the ongoing investigation.

The case has drawn public attention on social media, with hashtags calling for justice trending locally.

Muskan's family has appealed to provincial authorities to intervene and ensure that the investigation is conducted without bias or external pressure.
