Authorities Launch Search for Missing 14-Year-Old from Musselburgh

An urgent appeal has been issued by Police Scotland following the disappearance of 14-year-old Calvin Whyte from Musselburgh, East Lothian. Officers are conducting a widespread search across multiple regions in a bid to locate the teenager and ensure his safety.

Calvin was last seen on Wednesday, 30 July 2025, and concerns for his welfare have continued to grow. He is described as white, approximately 5ft 7in tall, of slim build, with short, dark hair. At the time of his disappearance, he was wearing a grey Adidas tracksuit,

along with a black, grey, and white McKenzie-branded bodywarmer. He was also carrying a black satchel and was known to wear black-framed glasses.

Police have confirmed that Calvin is familiar with several areas in Scotland, including East Lothian, Midlothian, and Edinburgh. He is also known to travel frequently to Glasgow and North Lanarkshire.

Inspector Keith Watson of Police Scotland stated: “We are becoming increasingly concerned for Calvin’s safety and wellbeing. We want to trace him as soon as possible to ensure that he is safe and well. Officers are currently carrying out searches and conducting enquiries in Musselburgh, Edinburgh, and other areas he is known to visit.”

The public is urged to assist in the search effort. Anyone who may have seen Calvin or has information about his whereabouts is encouraged to contact Police Scotland on 101, quoting incident number 1253 of 30 July.

The situation remains a priority for authorities, and efforts to locate the missing boy continue. Updates will be provided as new information becomes available.
