

British Tourist Reported Missing in Turkey After Solo Boat Trip

A British man has been reported missing in Turkey after he failed to return from a solo rowing trip to visit ancient tomb sites near the Köyceğiz district. The incident occurred on the morning of 29 July, prompting a search operation involving local authorities. His daughter, who is also a British national, raised the alarm after losing contact with him.

The man had set off alone in a small boat, intending to explore the historic area, but did not return as expected. Turkish police were alerted and began search efforts shortly after the report was made. The UK Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office has confirmed it is aware of the case and is offering consular support to the family.

The disappearance adds to a growing list of recent concerns involving British citizens encountering difficulties while visiting Turkey. In previous months, there have been multiple incidents of tourists going missing or dying under unclear circumstances, leading to questions over safety and post-mortem investigations. Some cases have drawn public attention, particularly where families raised concerns over the condition of repatriated bodies.

In this latest case, Turkish authorities have said that while there is currently no indication of foul play, the man's age and the nature of the terrain have complicated the search. The area surrounding Köyceğiz is known for its natural beauty, but it can be hazardous due to isolated stretches of water, limited mobile reception, and minimal local surveillance.

Efforts to locate the missing man include checking hospitals, harbours, and nearby towns. Residents and tourists are being asked to report any sightings or relevant information. The lack of witnesses and the possibility that the man may have ventured into more remote or unmonitored areas has made the search more challenging.

Officials stress that travellers should take precautions when visiting unfamiliar areas, especially alone. Tourists are encouraged to inform

friends or relatives of their plans, avoid isolated regions without local guidance, and stay in regular contact during excursions.

As the search continues, the man's family is awaiting updates while Turkish authorities and consular teams work to determine his whereabouts. No further details have been released at this stage.
